

# Log Requirements



Your log is to be handed in on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2002, failure to meet this deadline could result in you failing the expedition.

Use a computer to complete your log if you have access to one, it will be easier to read and the overall appearance will be better. The inclusion of photos, illustrations and leaflets will make your log more enjoyable to read, so include them wherever possible.

If you need any help or advice please ask, as your log is as important to complete as the actual walk.

## Log Outline

Your log should be constructed, as follows please feel free to add in elements to enhance your work.

- Front Cover: Name  
Duke of Edinburgh (Bronze, Silver or Gold)  
Area Walked  
Date of Expedition
- 1<sup>st</sup> Page: Index
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Page: A few lines telling of previous practice expeditions, where and when.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Page: Name of Group  
Short descriptions of the individuals, maybe include a photo.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Page: List of equipment
- 5<sup>th</sup> Page: Menu
- 6<sup>th</sup> Page: Map or tracing of your route, maybe photocopied or scanned in.
- 7<sup>th</sup> Page: Route Card
- 8-10<sup>th</sup> Page: Log of your journey, explaining your experience.  
Use photos and illustrations to enhance your work.
- 11<sup>th</sup> Page: Topic Chosen – e.g.: Weather conditions, geographical area, places of interest.  
You can use the Internet to help you with this, and again use photos and illustrations to present your work.
- 12<sup>th</sup> Page: Conclusion
- 13<sup>th</sup> Page: Thanks to your assessor.
